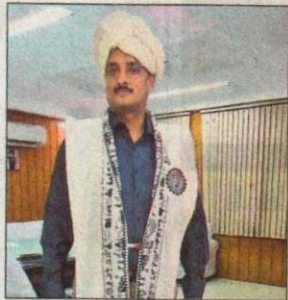


# AKTU nod to 'desi' convocation attire

**LUCKNOW:** Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Technical University has resolved to introduce Choice Based Credit System in undergraduate and postgraduate courses from the academic session 2016-17. To formulate rules, the university has constituted a four-member committee which will prepare a draft.

The academic council in its meeting held on Monday also resolved to include mother's name alongside father's name in the marksheet.

Also, the academic regalia (graduation gown) of the university has gone more indigenous. The academic council

has approved the traditional Indian garments to be worn by graduating engineering and

management students during the convocation.

The dress code includes stole (angvastra) and pagri (turban) for both boys and girls. Besides, boys will be required to come in white shirts and dark trousers while girls will have to wear sarees. The details have been uploaded on the university's website to invite more suggestions.

The university will give away 47 gold, silver and bronze medals to students in the convocation to be held in January 2016. The list of medal recipients has also been uploaded on the site.
