

APTU to go for online evaluation

Lucknow: Moving towards a transparent system, APJ Abdul Kalam Technical University is set to go in for digital evaluation. The answer sheets will be scanned and examiners will evaluate them on computer, instead of putting pen to paper. The online process will be carried out in a phased manner, beginning with postgraduate courses. Finance Committee members who met on Saturday gave in-principle agreement to the digital evaluation process. The move will benefit 4 lakh students in over 700 colleges across UP.

"The process will not only help in monitoring of answer sheets but also make re-evaluation easier," said Vinay Pathak, vice-chancellor, APJAK Technical University. The meeting also gave green signal to implementation of a module to record students' attendance using the ERP software.

Also, students will not have to stand in queues any more to deposit their sessional or practical examination fees. "Fees for sessional and practical examinations can be deposited online," said Pathak.
